General Purpose of Job:

Lead a group of approximately 10-15 students in an instructional setting, maintaining high standards for behavior and safety. Serve as a positive adult role model for children in the program through appropriate dress, speech, and attitude. **Reading Teacher** will work with students in a classroom setting and provide individual instruction and assistance to help students develop literacy skills. Duties include helping students read fluently, comprehend what they're reading, and train them in phonetics, spelling, grammar, and vocabulary memorization. **Reading Teacher** objective is to improve students' reading comprehension by using introducing students to cognitive strategies of effective readers such as activating, inferring, monitoring-clarifying, questioning, searching-selecting, summarizing, and visualizing-organizing. **Reading Teacher** will provide differentiated instruction to struggling readers.
